



Prof D Jagannatha Reddy (1915-91)


- August 05, 1915 : Born in Veeranathoor, Chittoor Dt
- He is the 6th of seven siblings
- 2 Elder brothers and 3 elder sisters are no more
- Younger sister, Mrs Vishalaxmamma, was residing in California, with her son Dr V Chandra Reddy, Surgeon, passed away on 29/03/2007
- Schooling: Board High School, Chittoor
- MBBS : Madras Medical College
- MD (Pathology) : Madras Medical College

Prof D Jagannatha Reddy (1915-91)

- Served as a Captain during Second World War
- 1941 : Married in Indore, while he was in Army
- Tutor in Pathology, Madras Medical College
- 1949-54 : Professor of Forensic Medicine, Andhra Medical College, Vizag

- Demise: December 13, 1991 at the age of 76









- Passed away on 31-10-2008, at the age of 94



DJR Anecdotes

- 1. He finds student walking on grass. He calls & says : Do you know where you're walking?
- You're walking on my heart. Gurumurthy fine him 50 paise
- 2. Student comes without shave or haircut. He calls him & says : Gurumurthy give him 50 paise. Ask him go to a barber shop
- 3. All seats in class are numbered. Attendance is marked by noting the vacant seats. Next class, he asks the absentees for explanation or he says: I saw you in railway station? What were you doing?

4. In the class he asks: What is transplantation?

If the student doesn't answer, he asks where are you from? Student: Tenali sir

DJR: Tenali is not London not to know transplantation. Go and ask your grandfather, he'd tell you what is transplantation of paddy

5. He'd say : King Dasaratha had 4 wives

Some student: No sir, only 3 wives & 4 sons

DJR: Who's that? I don't care how many wives Dasatatha had. Take the moral from it. Dasaratha had 4 wives, sit down!

- 6. As 2nd yr students we were busy ragging the juniors & in the process we also assaulted one student from Ghana, who was overacting. The matter went to Ghana High Commission, Govt of India, to DMS & finally to our Principal to submit a report. He simply warned the students & wrote to the Govt that nothing serious had happened & closed the case.
- 7. When were 3rd yr students, one night some of our girl students went to a late night movie. On return they got into some trouble and were taken to Police Station (don't remember details). When they identified as Medical students, Police informed the Principal. He immediately rushed to Police Station, got them released to took them to the Hostel.

8.In the farewell function (1962), he revealed the secret why he never allowed other person to talk, while scolding him. He said the other person may make a valid point & he might have to stop shouting

9. On my return from US, I met him in Tirupathi (1970) (Vice Chancellor, S V University). He was happy that I decided to settle down in Madras & advised me: if you're building something, build hospital first; from its revenue, you can build a house, because house doesn't generate any income

• 10. When he was the VC of SVU (1975), he built a small house in Washermenpet, Madras. The contractor after receiving full amount, started giving him trouble & sent him a Lawyer Notice demanding more money. DJR was shaken up & requested me to some how settle the matter. I was then Asst. Prof at Stanley Medical College. I found out that the contractor was a Teacher in a Govt School. I wrote a letter to him that if gives trouble to our teacher, I'd take the matter to TN Education Minister. Knowing my background, he immediately surrendered, met me & withdrew the case, without further claim.

11. Prof DJR visited Stanley Med College in 1989, as MCI Inspector, to grant permission for new PG courses. As soon as he came to the College & met our Dean in his Office, he expressed desire to meet me. I was with him for two days during the Inspection & attended the Dinner hosted by the College in his honor. I prevailed upon him to grant permission to all the Courses, for which the College applied for. This gesture elevated my reputation in the College circles.


- 12. Prof DJR recommended my name to the Pondicherry University in 1989, for setting the question papers for their Surgical PG Exams.
 On receiving the request from the University, giving me some guidelines, I'd set Theory
 Papers for MS (Gen) Exams for two years.
- I conveyed my gratitude to him for giving me such an honorable assignment.
- He never forgets any one who helped him, especially his students

13. In 1990, New Building of my Hospital in Kilpauk, Chennai, was to be inaugurated by the Chairman, Sri Ramachandra Medical College, Sri NPV Ramaswamy Udayar. Prof DJR also graced the occasion.

As Sri Udayar was about to cut the ribbon, I pointed to him that my teacher was in the audience. He promptly invited him to stand by his side and cut the ribbon. Then I touched the feet of Dr DJR, to invoke his blessings, which was appreciated by Sri Udayar.
